### Soliderrance... a family history

My father, passionate about Africa, fulfills his dream in 2017 by creating Soliderrance. This association brings travelers into the heart of Senegal and contributes to the development of the village they visit, Kamiak. The goal: to create immersive travel experiences for travelers who help the village's development by funding trees and seeds planting.



As for me, after 13 years of commercial management in the sports industry (including 9 years at adidas in France and Colombia) and driven by a need for coherence, I resign in 2019 to pursue another dream: backpacking through Latin America. A 14-days lockdown in March 2020 in a small village in Patagonia is the final turning point!

Given the family legacy, I decide in December 2020 to give new momentum to my father's initiative. Soliderrance SAS is finally born in October 2021.



I thus transform my passion for travel into a professional activity aligned with my personal values. Soliderrance will serve as a means to create opportunities for exchange, sharing, and discovery. The aim: to show, during one stay, that a way of life which preserves and regenerates territories is possible. The intention: to plant a small seed in curious travelers seeking meaning, inspiring them to pursue a sustainable and peaceful life.

The traveler **mitigates** the carbon footprint of the transatlantic flight through an amount included in the ticket, which is redistributed to an association that creates a food forest.





Hello! I'm Dani and I will be guiding you during this immersive retreat. To me, sharing the teachings of yoga and the tools acquired throughout my life journey is a true passion. Rather than simply teaching postures, my goal is to lead each of you to an exciting adventure towards connecting with yourselves, awakening a deep awareness both internally and externally.

My goal is to create sensory experiences that allow each participant to flourish, find joy and, above all, reconnect with the simple pleasures of life. In each session, my commitment is to provide support, love and create an atmosphere of total acceptance. "I firmly believe in the magic that happens when body and mind intertwine in perfect harmony."



With each retreat, workshop or class, my goal goes beyond simply guiding a practice. I try to teach how to use each tool we explore, so that it is easy to integrate them into everyday life.

This practice, in my experience, has a more significant impact on the process lived during and after retirement.

During each class, we will work step by step on awareness of our body, mind and emotions during our meditations.



The classes are divided into sessions of:

- Active and Passive Breathing: we will understand their functioning, sequences and how to apply them in our daily life.
- Yoga Postures: thank to the small size of the group, each practice will be personalized according to the needs of the day, following a body detox rhythm to prepare those who choose ancestral medicine.
- Meditation practices: we will explore different types of meditation, including passive, active and visualization, among others.
- Relaxation practices (Aromatherapy): they include therapeutic eye pillows and diffusion of essential oils, allowing one to achieve deep states of relaxation during the Savasana posture, practicing yoga Nidra.



You will immerse yourself along the El Arenal River and reach this little paradise after about a 30-minute walk through the lush forest.





Our contribution may take the form of participating in local activities and/or making a symbolic donation to the association or foundation hosting us (if applicable). If such a financial contribution is involved, it will have been specified and validated in the attached signed quote.

Moreover, we understand the importance of staying at least three days in the places we visit to encourage sharing, exchange, and an immersive experience that benefits both our hosts and ourselves.

**Regenerative**: we recognize that the lifestyle and activities of the hosts we visit promote the regeneration of their environment. We are committed to doing everything we can to leave the area in a better state than when we arrived, thereby ensuring our presence has a positive and lasting impact.

By "regenerative," we also refer to the well-being of both ourselves and those who host us. This well-being may be expressed across three dimensions (physical, emotional, and spiritual) according to the wishes and needs of each individual.

We commit to being travelers who are:

#### Modification, Cancellation and/or termination provisions

Refer to the provisions of the "General Conditions of Sale" in force.

It is specified in advance that the Traveler does not benefit from the right of withdrawal for the purchase of tourist services in accordance with article L.221-28, 12° of the Consumer Code once the dates of the stay have been approved and signed on the Sustainable and Regenerative Travel Proposal.

Without prejudice to the application of the provisions of the "General Conditions of Sale" in force at the time of booking, it is specified that the content of the stays may be canceled or modified without notice by SOLIDERRANCE SAS in particular depending on certain local obligations (political events, security measures, etc.) or climatic conditions, during which the planned destinations are impossible to access.

As soon as these modifications substantially affect a fundamental element of the tourist package, SOLIDERRANCE SAS will inform the Client, who will have the choice of terminating the contract or accepting the modifications proposed by SOLIDERRANCE SAS.

The customer has the right to terminate the contract before the start of the trip or stay without paying a termination fee if exceptional and unavoidable circumstances occurring at the place of destination or in the immediate vicinity result in significant consequences for the execution of the contract or on the transport of passengers to the place of destination. In this case, the traveler is entitled to a full refund of payments made but not to additional compensation.

The customer may terminate the contract at any time before the start of the trip or stay, upon payment of appropriate resolution fees or, where applicable, standard resolution fees claimed by SOLIDRRANCE (see the General Conditions of Sale) and this, in accordance with I of article L. 211-14;

The conditions for modifications, cancellations and/or termination at the initiative of the customer or SOLIDERRANCE SAS are detailed in the General Conditions of Sale in force.



Cancellation: the Traveler can cancel their Solidarity and Regenerative Trip.

# Language

The country you are going to visit is Colombia. The official language is Spanish. To fully benefit from the experience offered by Soliderrance, it is recommended to have a knowledge of the language of the host country. If this is not the case, you can use an interpreter guide permanently during your trip, or occasionally during certain activities. The cost of this service will have been clearly stipulated to you in the attached quote.

# Visa Passport and COVID 19

We invite you to visit the site: https://www.diplomatie.gouv.fr/fr/conseils-aux-voyageurs/conseils-par-pays-destination/colombie/. There you will find all the latest updated information.

VISA:

Holders of a French passport can enter Colombia without a visa and stay there for a maximum period of 90 days, upon presentation of a return ticket.

#### COVID 19:

All travelers must complete the online Check Mig form before boarding. As of May 1st, 2022, international travelers over the age of 18 traveling to Colombia must present to enter the territory:

- for people vaccinated with at least 2 doses: a vaccination certificate.
- for unvaccinated people or people vaccinated with a single dose: the negative result of a PCR test less than 72 hours old or an antigen test less than 48 hours old.

The vaccines accepted in Colombia are the two-dose vaccines Pfizer, Sinovac, AstraZeneca, Moderna and the single-dose Janssen vaccine. The last dose must occur 14 days before the travel date to be considered vaccinated.

The certificate of recovery is not recognized in Colombia and is not equivalent to a dose.



# **Currency and change**

Colombia's currency is the Colombian Pesos COP.

You will often see a \$ sign in front of the number but this does not mean an amount in USD. They use this sign for Colombian pesos. For example you can see displayed \$2000 which means 2000 Colombian pesos (2000 cop) or ~ 0.5€. The current exchange rate is around 1€ = 4800 cop. We recommend the website www.xe.com to find out more.

Tipping: in Colombia your bill at the restaurant will always be presented to you excluding the "servicio" (the tip). Your server will ask you if you want to include the tip in your payment with the phrase: "desea incluir el servicio?" ". It is customary to answer yes, unless you are excessively dissatisfied with the service.

This Sustainable and Regenerative Travel Proposal established by SOLIDERRANCE SAS (also called quote) supplements or modifies the General Conditions of Sale.

They define the conditions for purchasing the services offered by SOLIDERANCE SAS and constitute part of the prior information referred to in the article R.211-4 of the Tourism Code.

All of this information is intended to inform customers/travelers, prior to signing their Contract, of the content of (i) the services offered relating to transport and stay, (ii) the price and payment terms, (iii) conditions for cancellation and modification of the contract as well as conditions for crossing borders (Visa in particular). 
